

## HANNIBAL HAMLIN – CHRONOLOGY

- 1809, Jan. 30: Hannibal (Jr.) born at Waterford, ME
- 1811, Sep. 8: Father, Hannibal (Sr.), dies at Waterford, ME
- 1835, Jan. 17: Marries Abigail Abbott at Waterford, ME
- 1837: Daughter Abigail F. is born at Waterford, ME (died 1907)
- 1839: Daughter Ellen M. is born at Waterford, ME (died 1840)
- 1840, Apr. 5: Mother, Susannah, dies at Waterford, ME
- 1840: Family moves to Union, ME where Hannibal establishes himself as a merchant
- 1840: Hannibal writes 2 hymns sung at the dedication of the Congregationalist Church, Temple, ME
- 1841: Son Hannibal is born at Union ME (died 1844)
- 1842: The family moves to Boston, MA where Hannibal establishes himself as a merchant
- 1843: Son Cyrus is born at Boston, MA (died 1923)
- 1844-46: Listed as “trader, h. 3 Bowdoin sq.” (Boston City Directory)
- 1848: Listed as “Fountain House, h. Beach, cor. Harrison ave.” (Boston City Directory)
- 1849: Listed as “trader, h. 151 Broadway” (Boston City Directory)
- 1850: Listed as “provisions, C near 4<sup>th</sup>, h. E, cor. Athens” (Boston City Directory)
- 1852: Listed as “Clerk, P.O., h. E, cor. Athens” (Boston City Directory)
- 1853: Listed as “Clerk, P.O., h. 38 Charles” (Boston City Directory)
- 1854: Listed as “h. 116 Hudson” (Boston City Directory)
- 1855-56: Listed as “insur. agent, American Mutual Life Ins. Co., 13 Exchange, h. Waverly (Boston City Directory)
- 1857, Jun. 1: Wife, Abigail, dies at Waverly, MA (*Boston Recorder*, June 11, 1857)
- 1857-59: Listed as “insur. Agent, 27 State “ (Boston City Directory)
- 1861: Listed as “agt. New England Mutual Life Ins., 39 State st.” (Boston City Directory)
- 1861: Listed as “Hannibal Hamlin, 3<sup>rd</sup> Auditor's office, \$1,400, born ME aptd. MA” (U.S. Official Register, vol. 1861)

1862, Mar. 21: Elected President of the newly formed National Freedman's Relief Association of the District of Columbia (*Evening Star*, Mar. 22, 1862)

1862, Nov. 13 Died, 273 F St. N.W.

1863, Apr. 17 Interred Congressional Cemetery.
